Regents Park Christian School GATEway Scholarship Application Year 7 2023



Regents Park Christian School will be offering a number of academic scholarships to students enrolling in Year 7 2023. The scholarship winners will be entitled to the following –

- Reduced school fees for Years 7 and 8 tuition.
- Reduced cost of summer and winter school supplied uniform.
- A school supplied Microsoft Surface tablet (breakages and repairs are the responsibility of the parent).
- A position in the Year 7 2023 GATEway class

Application Process

1. Applicants must **complete the attached application form by Friday 8th April 2022**. This form, along with the required supporting documentation, is to be returned to the school office and marked "Scholarship Application: Attention Mrs Melinda Gindy". No late applications will be accepted.
2. Applicants must also complete the regular school enrolment process.
3. All applicants will be required to complete **standardised testing on Monday 2nd May 2022 from 10.00am to 2pm** at RPCS.
4. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their scholarship application during week commencing Monday 16th May 2022.

Conditions of Scholarship

1. Applications are open to both new enrolments and current students entering Year 7 in 2022.
2. Successful candidates will be able to demonstrate academic excellence.
3. Successful candidates must meet enrolment requirements, i.e. complete enrolment forms, supply necessary documentation for enrolment and attend an enrolment interview.
4. Successful candidates will maintain a high academic standard while students at RPCS. This includes attendance and application to learning.
5. The school reserves the right to review the progress of the scholarship recipient as it deems necessary. If expected progress is not maintained, the student and parents will be notified, and the scholarship benefits may be in jeopardy.
6. Scholarships will be offered to students entering Year 7 with each scholarship being of a two-year duration.
7. The family must have accepted the offer of enrolment, including payment of the full bond, by Friday 10th June 2022.
8. Parents must remain up to date with school fees.
9. Parents must maintain all the conditions of enrolment concurrently.
10. The number of scholarships available each year is entirely at the Principal's discretion.
11. The scholarship is not transferable or redeemable for cash.
12. If a student leaves the school before the end of Year 8, the family will supply the school with the student's uniform and Surface tablet. Failure to do so will render the parents liable for the deemed value of the non-returned items.
13. Parents will immediately pay for loss of the Surface tablet or any damage to the Surface tablet and ensure it remains in good working order.
14. Parents agree to allow the student to participate in both external competitions and extracurricular activities as determined by the school.
15. The scholarship can be cancelled by the school at any time if it deems that there has been a breach of conditions.
16. The parents give permission for the student's name and photographs to be used publicly as deemed appropriate by the school. This includes the school website and for marketing purposes.

- Personal interests e.g. instruments played, books you like to read, computer interests, travel etc.
- Anything else you would like us to know about you

Supporting documentation

In addition to the application form and student letter, the following supporting documentation must be submitted:

- Copy of Year 5 2021 NAPLAN Results
- Copy of Semester 2 2021 school report
- PLUS any of the following –
 - Awards and certificates that might support your application e.g. UNSW Global ICAS tests, participation in university-based programs, psychometric assessment etc.
